"I acknowledge that I have been provided a copy of the Original Petition for Divorce filed in this case. I have read and understand the contents of that document.

I acknowledge that all allegations in the file-marked copy of the Original Petition for Divorce provided to me, regarding any children named therein, are of my own knowledge and belief, true and correct.

"I understand that the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure require, in most instances, that a party or respondent be served with citation. I do not want to be served with citation, and I waive the issuance and service of citation.

"I waive the making of a record of testimony in this case.

"I agree that this case may be taken up and considered by the Court without further notice to

me.

"I agree that the pleadings may be amended without furnishing me a copy of the amended pleadings prior to final hearing in this case.

"I agree that any preexisting case involving any or all of my minor children, may be transferred without prior notice to me, to the court in which this action is filed.

"I agree that the case may be decided by the presiding Judge of the Court or by a duly appointed Associate Judge of the Court.

"I further understand that I have a duty to notify the Court if my mailing address changes during this proceeding."

"I acknowledge that Petitioner and Respondent are required to submit an agreed 'Parenting Plan' for all children who are the subject of this suit. If a mutually agreeable 'Parenting Plan' is not reached, each party is to submit an individual 'Parenting Plan' including a sworn statement of income as prescribed by Chapter 154 of the Texas Family Code. Such sworn statement should also state that it is proposed in good faith and is in the best interest of all children who are the subject of this suit. I do not wish to submit a 'Parenting Plan.'

"I further state that I have read the pleadings concerning the paternity of the children and the facts as stated therein are true and correct to my best knowledge and belief and are as set forth

therein.”
